

DAY 1 Depart USA

DAY 2 Arrival in Cape Town, South Africa:

TABLE BAY HOTEL - Luxury room

Welcome to Cape Town! Upon arrival and after completing customs and immigration procedures, you will be met by your Big Five representative and transferred to your hotel

DAY 3 Cape Town:

TABLE BAY HOTEL - Luxury room (B)

Explore the city of Cape Town, known affectionately as the Mother City. Your tour will take in the Houses of Parliament, the Castle (built between 1666 and 1679, this is South Africa's oldest building), the lively Greenmarket Square with its daily market, the Company Gardens and of course Table Mountain, which will give you spectacular views over the city and the Peninsula. As you come back down from the mountain, make a stop at Bo-Kaap, home to the Cape Malay community, with its cobbled streets and brightly colored houses. From here you have the choice of being dropped off at the Waterfront to experience this vibrant location at your own pace, with its many shops, restaurants and pubs - or at your hotel to end the tour.

DAY 4 Cape Town:

TABLE BAY HOTEL - Luxury room (B,L)

Today you embark on a full day tour of the Cape Peninsula. Take in the beaches of Clifton and Camps Bay, before crossing over to Hout Bay, where you may choose to join an optional boat cruise to Seal Island. From here you drive to the Cape of Good Hope Nature Reserve via Chapman's Peak, one of the world's most breathtaking coastal drives, where you will board a funicular to get to the top of the Peninsula to witness the symbolic meeting of the Indian and Atlantic Oceans and enjoy spectacular views over False Bay. After lunch continue to Simonstown, the naval base, and visit the African Penguin breeding colony at Boulders Beach. Then stop at the world-renowned Kirstenbosch Gardens before arriving at your hotel for overnight.

DAY 5 Cape Town:

TABLE BAY HOTEL-Luxury room (B,L)

This delightful drive winds its way to the heart of the Cape Winelands, through superb mountain ranges, vineyards and Cape Dutch homesteads. With award-winning wine and delicious food on offer, a wine tasting at Spier is one of the most popular options in the Stellenbosch area and the first stop on today's tour. Continue to the wine country via the N2 to the heart of South Africa's wine industry, Stellenbosch. Walk down the canal-lined avenues, in the shade of giant oak trees and beautifully preserved historic buildings. Middlelevlei in the Devon Valley is genuinely relaxed and down to earth and the perfect stop for a traditional South African barbeque (braai) lunch. Travel over the Helshoogte Pass to the town of Franschhoek, historically dating back to the 17th century when the French Huguenots arrived. In Franschhoek board the Wine Tram for a unique and leisurely way to see the Valley as they journey through rolling vineyards in an open sided double-decker railway tram while enjoying a narration focusing on the history of the Franschhoek Valley and unparalleled views of the landscape and vineyards. Stop at Boschednal Wine Estate for a tasting before returning to your hotel by coach.

DAY 6 Cape Town-Thornybush Game Reserve:

THORNYBUSH WATERSIDE LODGE - SUITE (B,D)

Today you will be transferred to the airport to take your flight to the Sabi Sands Game Reserve, where upon arrival you will be met and transferred to your hotel. Even though there is a 50km unfenced boundary with the Kruger National Park, the game in the Sabi Sands reserve is well habituated resulting in unforgettable close encounters and prolific sightings, particularly of the elusive leopard. The Sabi and the Sand Rivers run through the reserve, which add further dimension to the bio-diversity of this area. Thornybush Game Reserve is 11 500 hectares of pristine African bushveld in the Olifants Valley near the Town of Hoedspruit. The reserve is adjacent to the Timbavati Game Reserve and borders the world-famous Kruger National Park, making it a premier game viewing area, with a huge diversity of mammal and bird species. Guests can unwind beside the pool, between game drives and guided bush walks, and evenings are spent in the boma, gathered around a blazing camp fire.

DAY 7 & 8 Thornybush Game Reserve:

THORNYBUSH WATERSIDE LODGE - SUITE (B,D)

Enjoy two full days of game activities.

DAY 9 Thornybush Game Reserve- Sabi Sands Game Reserve- Livingstone, Zambia: DAVID LIVINGSTONE SAFARI LODGE & SPA-(B,D)

This morning you will be transferred to the airport to take your flight to Livingstone, where upon arrival you will be met and transferred to your hotel, situated just upstream from the magnificent Victoria Falls in Zambia, on the banks of the Zambezi River. Nearby optional activities include white-water rafting, Victoria Falls visits, river cruises and a host of other scenic and adventure options. The newly built lady Livingstone famously known as "The Jewel of the Zambezi" has a capacity of 144 pax. The cruise takes place along the river boundary of the Mosi-oa-Tunya National Park. During the cruise, clients are likely to see hippos, crocodile and some good birdlife. Possible other game sightings are elephant, giraffe, buffalo and buck. An experienced guide accompanies each cruise and has good knowledge on the wildlife and local history of the area.

DAY 10 Livingstone, Zambia:

DAVID LIVINGSTONE SAFARI LODGE & SPA- (B,D)

This morning enjoy a visit to the falls followed by a visit the nearby market. The afternoon is at leisure.

DAY 11 Livingstone- Depart Johannesburg for USA: (B)

Today you will be transferred to the airport to take your flight to Johannesburg, where you will connect with your international homebound flight.

DAY 12 Arrive in USA
