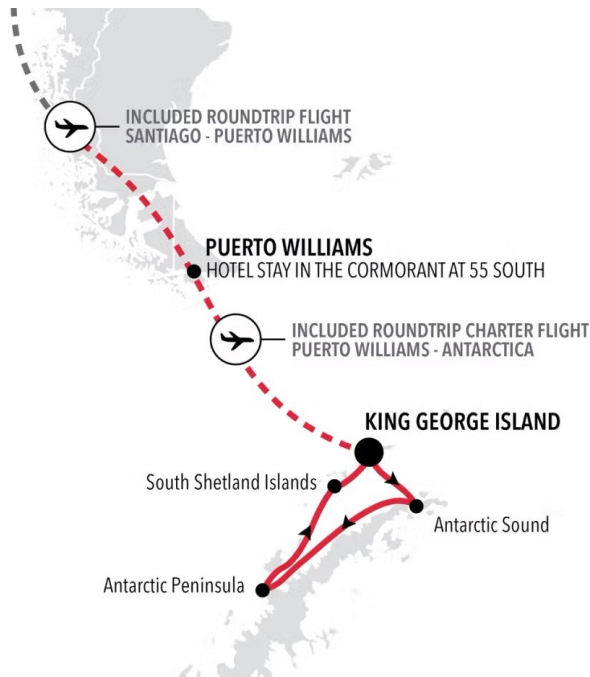

Day to Day Itinerary:

Day 1 (January 14) Depart US

Day 2 (January 15) Arrive Santiago, Chile. Transfer to your 5* hotel for an early check-in. Join your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner. (D)

Day 3 (January 16) Half-day city tour of Santiago. (B,D)

Day 4 (January 17) Depart from Santiago and fly to Puerto Williams. Check into Silversea's new luxury hotel, *Cormorant @ 55 South*, the world's southernmost hotel. During your stay, get fitted and receive all the gear you will need for your adventure. (B)

Day 5 (January 18) Charter flight from Puerto Williams over the infamous Drake Passage to King George Island. Transfer and embark on your home for the next 6 nights – Silversea's *Silver Endeavor*. (B,D)

Day 6 (January 19) Antarctic Sound (B,L,D)

Day 7 (January 20) Antarctic Sound (B,L,D)

Day 8 (January 21) Antarctic Sound (B,L,D)

Day 9 (January 22) Antarctic Sound (B,L,D)

Day 10 (January 23) Antarctic Sound (B,L,D)

Day 11 (January 24) Disembark on King George Island. Charter flight to Puerto Williams where you will enjoy another overnight stay at the lovely *Cormorant @ 55 South*. (B)

Day 12 (January 25) Flight from Puerto Williams to Santiago. You may choose to continue with a flight home to the US, or to the destination of your choice. (B)

Day 13 (January 26) Arrive in the US

CANCELLATION POLICY

Silversea's cancellation fees as mentioned below are strictly enforced with no exceptions. Silversea recommends that guests purchase cancellation insurance to protect themselves against unforeseen cancellations and emergencies. No refund or adjustment will be made in the event of interruption or cancellation of the cruise holiday after the commencement of same. Silversea reserves the right to re-invoice in the event of errors.

From deposit up to 151 days prior to sailing Until Aug 20, 2026 \$250 per person*

150-121 days prior to sailing Aug 21, 2026 - Sep 19, 2026 15% of full fare

120-91 days prior to sailing Sep 20, 2026 - Oct 19, 2026 25% of full fare

90-61 days prior to sailing Oct 20, 2026 - Nov 18, 2026 50% of full fare

0-31 days prior to sailing Nov 19, 2026 - Dec 18, 2026 75% of full fare

30-0 days prior to sailing Dec 19, 2026 - Jan 18, 2027 100% of full fare

* This fee will be converted to a future cruise credit (FCC) redeemable on a new booking made up to 2 years after cancellation, on any sailing commencing no later than one year after the expiry date of the FCC.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

FINAL PAYMENT: If final payment is not received by specified date, we reserve the right to cancel the reservation. In case of billing errors, we reserve the right to re-invoice with correct pricing.

REVISION FEES: Handling fee of \$50.00 per transaction will be charged for any revisions. Spelling corrections to clients' names after air tickets have been issued are subject to airline revision fees.

PASSPORTS AND VISAS: A valid passport is required of all tour participants. It must be valid six months after date of return. Non US Citizens must consult with the appropriate consulates to determine if any visas are needed.

TRAVELERS WHO NEED SPECIAL ASSISTANCE: Any condition or disability requiring special attention must be reported to Humble Travel at the time of booking. Humble Travel will make reasonable efforts to accommodate the special needs of disabled tour participants, but is not responsible for any denial of service by carriers, hotels, restaurants, or other independent suppliers.

PRICES: The tour price is per person based on two persons sharing a room. All prices are based on rates (including foreign exchange rates) known at time of printing and expected to be in effect at time of departure. Prices, including taxes and fees, are subject to change without notice if such rates change prior to departure.

BAGGAGE: Portage for one checked suitcase and one carry-on suitcase on tour is included in price. Airport portage at beginning and end of tour is not included. Checked bags should not exceed dimensions of 62 linear inches and weight of 50 pounds. Wheeled carry-ons are not allowed on motor coaches.

RESPONSIBILITY: Humble Travel and Silversea Cruises (hereinafter to refer as "the Operators") are responsible to you in making arrangement for tour service offers in this brochure, including transportation, sightseeing and hotel accommodations. The carriers, hotels and other suppliers providing tour service are independent contractors and are not principals, agents, employees, partners or joint ventures of the Operators or its affiliates. The tour participant agrees that neither the Operators or its affiliates shall be liable for any damaged, lost (including personal injury, death and property loss) or expense occasioned by any act of omission of supplier providing tour services, or any insurer or insurance administer under a travel protection plan, or of any other person. If the services included in the tour cannot be supplied or there are changes an itinerary for reasons beyond the control of the Operators, the Operators will arrange for the provision of comparable services, when possible. Any resulting additional expense will be payable by the tour participants and any resulting savings will be refunded by the Operators to tour participant.
